Bill updating Law N 209-FZ (24.07.2007) by abolishing limitations of foreign companies in the statutory capital of SMEs adopted:	03.08.2018	<u>Duma</u>
<ul> <li>applies only to SMEs according to RU definition (max 250 employees, max RUB 2 bn turnover)</li> </ul>		
▶ allows SMEs held by foreign SMEs (s. above) to benefit from special SME incentives		
<ul> <li>does not apply to SMEs registered in offshore locations</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>restrictions for SMEs held by bigger foreign entities remain in force</li> </ul>
