Electronic visas

Background

- The increase in revenues from inbound tourism is one of the tasks set by President Vladimir Putin in March 2018
- Exports of services in the category of travel with tourist, medical and educational purposes in 2024 should reach \$ 15.47 billion
 - (Now by the end of 2017 only \$8.95 billion)
- Ministry of Foreign Affairs supported with special view: "principle of reciprocity" in visa issues

International exhibition organizer's view

- 18 ITE events in 2018 attended by 250 000+ visitors
- 20 000+ foreigners (business, science and government representatives)
- E-visas would significantly increase the flow of foreign entrepreneurs
- We plan to send the Expo ID project directly to the President
