



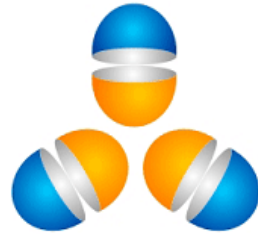

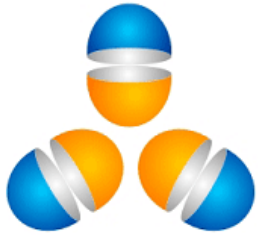
ACTO: The main objectives

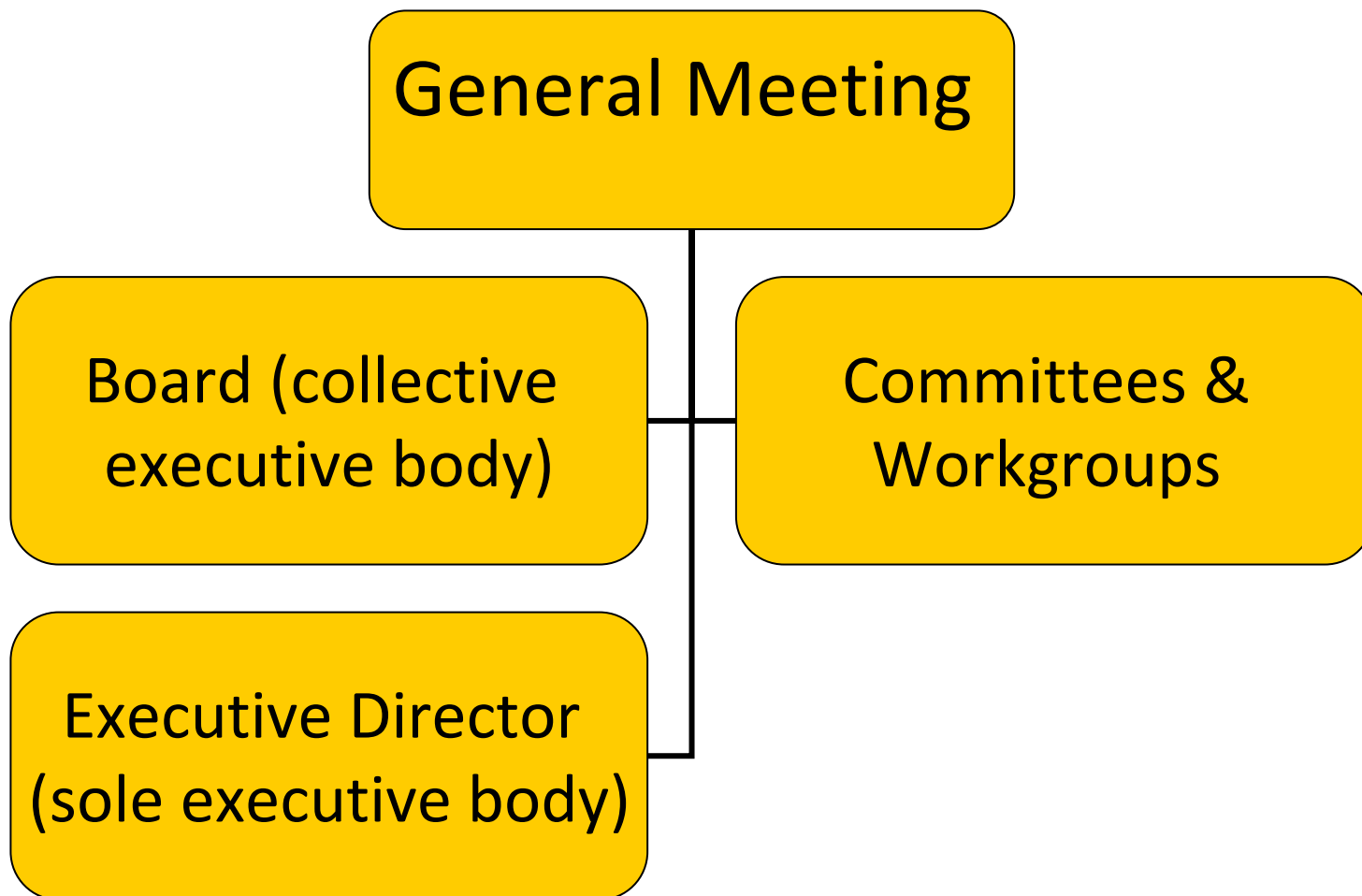
