**Evgeny Gavrilenkov** serves as Managing Director and Chief Economist at CJSC "Sberbank CIB" and Sberbank Investment Research. Before joining Sberbank CIB (known as Troika Dialog until October 2012) in 2002, Mr. Gavrilenkov worked at the Bureau of Economic Analysis. Between 1992 and 1996, he served at the Center for Economic Analysis, a government think-tank, first as Head of Department, then Deputy Director and Acting Director. Mr. Gavrilenkov is a professor and Head of the Department of Applied Macroeconomics at the Higher School of Economics and Director of the Institute of Macroeconomic Research and Forecasting. In the mid-90s, Mr. Gavrilenkov was a guest professor several times at Hitotsubashi University, Japan, and a visiting researcher at the Economic Research Institute (run by the government of Japan). He has also been a guest researcher at the Bank of Finland, a visiting professor at the Sorbonne Pantheon University in Paris, and a visiting researcher at the International Monetary Fund (1994, 2001). Mr. Gavrilenkov serves as Chairman of Index Committee at MICEX Stock Exchange Closed Joint Stock Company. Mr. Gavrilenkov received a degree in Mathematics from the Moscow Aviation Institute in 1978 and a PhD in Economics in 1985.

**Chris J. Weafer** has worked in Russia for more than fifteen years. Most recently he was voted the best Russia investment strategist for 2013 by investors in separate polls carried out by Thomson Reuters Extel and Institutional Investor magazine. He has regularly placed in the top three of these respective polls over the past ten years.

Before leaving to co-found Macro Advisory, Chris held the position of Chief Strategist at Sberbank-CIB, Russia's largest bank and one of the biggest banks in Europe. Prior to that he served for four years as Chief Strategist with Uralsib Financial Corporation and for five years with Alfa Bank, two of Russia's largest privately owned financial groups. in Russia was as Head of Research with Troika Dialog, a privately owned investment bank, from June 1998. He held that position for over four years.

Prior to coming to Russia Chris worked as Head of Research for NatWest Markets in Bangkok, Thailand, during the Asian financial crisis of 1997/'98. Before that he was Senior Investment Manager at the Abu Dhabi Investment Authority, one of the world's largest sovereign wealth funds, based in Abu Dhabi City. Chris started his investment career with the Irish Life Assurance Company in Dublin, Ireland, and has accumulated over thirty three years' experience in emerging markets.

**Vladimir Andrienko** joined Russia Partners as a Managing Director in January 1998. Mr. Andrienko is the head of the Firm's Moscow office and sits on the Russia Partners Management. From 1993 to 1997, he was with PwC in Washington, D.C. and Moscow, ultimately becoming a Partner in charge of the firm's Corporate Finance department in Moscow. Prior to joining PwC, he was Vice President of Foreign Sales Development and Finance at Gazprom from 1988 to 1991. From 1982 to 1988, he was Assistant to the Minister at the Russian Ministry of Gas.

Mr. Andrienko holds a B.A. from Moscow State University and an M.B.A. from Harvard Business School. He currently serves as a member of the board of directors of a number of companies in Russia Partners' portfolio.
